With reference to Mr. Indian Agent  
Beattie's letter where ~~it~~ he asks for a  
resurvey of the Reserve of the Moravians  
of the Thames, which was moved and  
carried at a meeting of the Council of the  
Moravians of ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~land~~ and that the expenses  
incurred in the survey be paid from the Capital  
funds of the Band & repaid to the Capital  
in a ~~part~~ <sup>part</sup> number of years from the  
interest on ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> of each year to the amount  
of \$75 per annum.

I do not see that Mr. Bray can be spared  
from this Office to make this resurvey there  
being too much work still to be done.  
But would recommend that if you see  
fit that Mr. Green be written to to do this  
work and that a copy of the Plan of the  
reserve be forth with sent him with  
instructions for the survey. But should  
you deem it necessary that Mr. Green  
proceed to the North West to aid Mr.  
Ponton in the work there. I would  
recommend that some local surveyor  
recommended by the M.P. of the locality  
might have the ~~the~~ work.
