
Ottawa, November 20th, 1909,

Rev. Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, in reference to the amount of the balance of grant paid to the Shingwauk Home for the quarter ended September 30th, last.

In reply I have to inform you that the earnings of this school for the September quarter, last, amounted to \$525.00, from which was deducted the sum of \$400.00, the amount of an advance sent on request of the former Principal, George Lee King, on July 26th, last. The quarterly return forwarded by you for the quarter in question showed an enrolment of 35 pupils for which the quarterly grant of \$15.00 each was allowed.
