

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 13th instant with which you forwarded an account in favor of Dr. Sylvester Hone for his expenses in proceeding to the Indian school at Lakalsay on the Naas River, I regret to say that the Department cannot consider the question of payment. It has not been customary in the past to pay the transport expenses of teachers when proceeding to the scene of their duties, and a precedent cannot be created in Dr. Hone's case.
