Sirs,-

I beg to inform you that a sample of the flour delivered for the Saddle Lake Agency to take the place of the quantity rejected has come to hand and been examined by the expert, who reports that he does not find it equal to the Standard sample and estimates the difference in value at 10 cents per bag in favour of the Standard. The flour will be accepted at a reduction in the contract price of 10 cents a bag.
