LONDON, August 5th, 1940.

No. 1295. Your telegram of August 4th, No. 1205. At the moment most of the British Consuls in France have returned here and the remaining ones do not act in official capacity, everything being done through United States Consular authorities. On the contrary French Consuls here are still exercising their functions.

Negotiations presently going on and position of British Consuls in France may be changed within a few days. Shall advise.
