

(4) Subject to the bylaws of the society a firm or an incorporated company may become a member of any society by the payment of the regular fee; but the name of one person only shall in any one year be entered as the representative or agent of such firm or company and that person only shall exercise the privileges of membership in the society. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 9.

SUPERINTENDENT OF FAIRS.

10. The commissioner may from time to time appoint a superintendent of fairs and institutes and such other officers as may be required to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance and may appoint an inspector to examine the books and accounts of any society and may confer on him any or all of the powers which may be conferred on a commissioner appointed under the provisions of *An Ordinance respecting Inquiries Concerning Public Matters*. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 10.

OFFICERS OF SOCIETY.

11. The officers of the society shall consist of a president and two vice presidents who shall be *ex officio* directors and nine, twelve or fifteen additional elected directors as may be determined by the society, a secretary and a treasurer or a secretary treasurer and two auditors. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 11.

12. The persons qualified to vote for officers or to be elected shall be only those members who have paid their membership fee for the year in which the election is held. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 12.

13. At the first annual meeting all of the officers except the secretary and the treasurer or the secretary treasurer shall be elected by ballot. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 13.

14. The president, vice presidents, directors and auditors elected at the first or any subsequent annual meeting shall hold office until the next following annual meeting. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 14.

15. The board of directors may from time to time appoint a secretary and a treasurer or a secretary treasurer who may be a director or directors and who shall hold office during pleasure. 1903 Sess. 1, c. 17, s. 15.
