MINUTES OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE
OF THE
PRESBYTERIAN CHURCHES,
IN THE
PROVINCES OF BRITISH NORTH AMERICA,
ON THE SUBJECT OF UNION.

At Montreal, and within St. Paul's Church there, on the 28th September, 1870, the Committees appointed on the subject of Union by the Supreme Courts of the following Churches, viz: The Presbyterian Church of Canada in connexion with the Church of Scotland — The Canada Presbyterian Church — The Presbyterian Church of the Maritime Provinces in connexion with the Church of Scotland, and the Presbyterian Church of the Lower Provinces met according to the call of the respective Conveners of these Committees.
