In April, the Secretary, Rev. Samuel N. Jackson, M.D., signified his intention of resigning the Secretaryship of the Society, on account of the pressure of pastoral duties. The Board parted with his services with great regret, after his efficient labours in his special office for the past three years. They felt constrained, however, to accept the resignation, and have made an interim appointment.
