## Commercial Report.

Breadstepes.-Flour is duller on a very light dehaad. The rivers are closed, and many of the schooners trading with outports are withdrawn; the demand is in consequence limited chiefly to the retail call of the city $\rightarrow$ no disposition is felt towards speculation, and it is impossible to effeec sales in any large quantities, there being no buyers except for daily use. Arrivals zeep pretty large, and flour is going into store, where it must remain until the demand overtakes the stock. Prices are $\$ 5.75$ to 86 , for common to good superfine, and 10 c . to 25 e . more for choice brands.
Corn meal unchanged.
Freighis, - Our freight market for deals continues very inactive; so much so, that it is difficult to make quotations. The tendener however appears to be downward. The following are the only charters reported since our last : Jones Brothers, 174, Bristol Channel, 72s. 6d., with $2 \mathrm{~s}, 6 \mathrm{~d}$. extra, if ordered to Bristol ; $C^{\prime} y d e$, 719, Bristol Channel, 70s. 6d.
