Our quotations, it should be understood, represent the wholesale prices generally. In the making up of small orders, higher prices have to be charged. All quotations are duty paid, unless otherwise stated.

## Commercial Report.

Breadstufffs.—Flour is duller on a very light demand. The rivers are closed, and many of the schooners trading with outports are withdrawn; the demand is in consequence limited chiefly to the retail call of the city—no disposition is felt towards speculation, and it is impossible to effect sales in any large quantities, there being no buyers except for daily use. Arrivals keep pretty large, and flour is going into store, where it must remain until the demand overtakes the stock. Prices are \$5.75 to \$6, for common to good superfine, and 10c. to 25c. more for choice brands.

Corn meal unchanged.

FREIGHTS.—Our freight market for deals continues very inactive; so much so, that it is difficult to make quotations. The tendency however appears to be downward. The following are the only charters reported since our last: Jones Brothers, 174, Bristol Channel, 72s. 6d., with 2s. 6d. extra, if ordered to Bristol; C'yde, 719, Bristol Channel, 70s. 6d.

For the West Indies freights are about as last reported. Transactions have been moderate, at about previous rates. We hear of the following: Abbey C. Titconb, 376, north side Cuba, shooks, 25c. and 26c.; Alfaretta, 228, same voyage, 25c., all under deck; Java, 162, Matanzas, 25c.; Leona, 300, Havana, 25c.; Martha, 131, Cardenas or Matanzas, boards, \$7.50 under, \$6.50 on deck, with 25c. additional for Havana; Alice Woods, 242, north side, 25c. under, 23c. on deck.

Coastwise freights are dull. We hear of the following transactions: Addie Reperson, 176, laths, \$1.20, and R. A. Ford, 114, at \$1.30, both for Philadelphia: Iris, 237, New York, laths, \$1.10; Duke of Newcastle, 86, Portland, shooks, 10c.; Belle, 98, and Clara, coais from Hillsboro' to Boston, \$1.90, gold.
