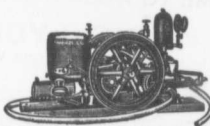

H. C. HOLBY'S CONSIGNMENT

H. C. Holby is sending eight head to Woodstock on March 25th, seven females and one male. A five-year-old cow, Hensveld Six, has a senior three-year-old record of 16.65. She is a cow, with big capacity, and will freshen near the time of the sale. She is out of Manilla Maud, by Hensveld John De Kol. Although she has no official record, Gladstone Queen, Howie's Butter Baron, and out of Daisy Netherland and Queen, will be a good one to add to any herd. She is seven years old, and the size to make a big record. Another cow, and out of Calumity Jane, Duesch Pouch, (1907), sired by Post Pouch Jane Pouch, has a record of 14.66. She is one that is sure to make good when given a fair test. A very persistent milker is Calumity Canary Pouch, who has a record of over 11 lbs. for the seven years. Her sire is Calumity Mervon.

Pouch Sarah Calumity Pictetie, Gladstone Queen's Netherland, and Edna Yeoman De Kol are also good ones that Mr. Holby is consoling. The last is a dam of whose sire has a record of 247 at seven years. Idaline Paul, two sons of Idaline Paul Veeman, has 11 proven daughters, and there are few sires of six years who out equal his showing. Practically all of the females in the consignment are bred to the herd sire, King Sogis Pictetie. The only sire Mr. Holby is offering is a yearling bull, Veeman King Sogis Pictetie, the dam Oethilde, whose seven nearest dams have 27 lbs. each. Through his dam he traces to Mr. Pictetie Netherland. This young bull is a fine straight individual, long and well marked.

NEW HOLSTEIN RECORDS

Editor, Farm and Dairy.—The Holstein cow, Briar Pictetie Abbeek No. 12773, has broken the record for fat production in the junior three-year class of the semi-official yearly division, by producing in 365 consecutive days 764.35 lbs. fat from 21,625 lbs. of milk. She freshened at the age of three years two months and six days. Her sire is Dutchland Rag Apple Sir Abbeek No. 5453, her dam is Pictetie Trantje De Kol, No. 4030. She is owned by Mr. F. W. Scott, Granville, N.Y.; and she is now owned by Mr. A. A. Knapp, Preble, N. Y. In the junior three-year class of the division she displaced Dutchland Changeling Chantia is 757.37 lbs. fat from 21,203 lbs. milk. Ten different supervisors were employed in the course of this test. The Holstein-Friesian cow, Lady Paul Livard 3rd, No. 16005, has broken the record for fat production in the junior two-year class of the semi-official yearly division, by producing in 365 consecutive days 737.35 lbs. fat from 20,887 lbs. milk. She freshened at the age of two years two months 28 days. Her sire is King Walker, No. 40539, her dam is Lady Paul Livard, No. 9635. She was bred by Mr. J. V. Abgart, Marion, Ind., and she is now owned by Mr. J. W. Dimick, Bifton, N.Y.—Malcolm H. Gardner, Supt. A. R.
