Preamble.

WHEREAS by minute of your Majesty's Executive Council of this Province, made on the Sixth day of July in this year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve upon reference by his Excellency Sir George Prevost, Baronet, your Majesty's Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over the Provinces of Lower-Canada, Upper-Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and their several dependencies, Lieutenant General and Commander of your Majesty's Forces in British North America, it was declared to be the unanimous opinion of that Board, That for the purposes of maintaining the means of circulation and answering the exigencies of the public service at this important conjuncture, it was advisable,
