(Continued from Page 1) "But here are a certain per centage of men qualified to pass on the question who admit there is a canker at the heart of Canada which only rays of the most heroic effort will overthrow."

The spoils system was condemned and it was suggested that the criminal code be amended to make it an offence to either give or take a bribe. The question of withholding the franchise from foreigners for five years instead of three was urged. Text books on citizenship for the schools was advised, the press and church appealed to and a plea made to abolish the whiskey bottle, not only in Ontario and a few other provinces on election day, but throughout the Dominion.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

ANY PERSON who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months residence upon cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-empt six months in each of three years; cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
