

SYNOPOPIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS. THE sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alber

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Albernine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residenc is prformed in the vectority. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing many pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years, after earning homestead pat-ut; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon is homestead patent, on certain condi-
