FAMINE IN RUSSIA IN MIDST OF PLENTY

The Railroads are Inadequate to Move the Food to the Big Cities

London, Jan. 29.—Russia is experiencing famine in the midst of plenty, according to an undated article in the Times, from a correspondent in that country. The article refers chiefly, but not exclusively, to Petrograd and Moscow. The writer believes that there is enough food in Russia to supply the entire population for two years but owing to the inadequacy of the railroads, the lack of organization and co-ordination in distribution, the people in some districts find it difficult and even impossible to get supplies.

The people of Petrograd have to stand in line for many hours to obtain meat, bread, sugar and vegetables. The thermometer in the capital is sometimes 20 below zero.

GREEKS SALUTED THE ALLIES FLAGS

London, Jan. 30.—The ceremony of saluting the Allies' flags by Greece was carried out Monday afternoon in the Zaphion in accordance with the arrangement recently entered into between the Greek Government and the Entente Powers, says a Reuter despatch from Athens. The Allied Ministers, the commander of the first army corps, and the members of the Greek Cabinet were present. The general public was excluded from the building. No untoward incident occurred.

IMPORTANCE OF SECURING VIGOROUS POTATO SEED STOCK

(Experimental Farms Note). Experiments conducted at the Dominion Experimental Station Kentville, N. S., with eight lots of Garnet Chili potatoes secured from different growers in 1915 shows a variation in yield of from 36 bushels to 240 bushels per acre, or a difference of 204 bushels per acre in yield when grown under uniform conditions. Seed from these eight lots planted in 1916 yielded from 68 bushels to 212 bushels per acre, a difference of 144 bushels per acre. The respective positions of the different lots were changed very little in the second year, but the lowest yielding ones increased somewhat and the highest yield was not so great.

Seed from fifteen others of this variety was planted in 1916 and the lowest yield obtained was 153 bushels and the highest 273 bushels per acre, a difference in favor of the best over the poorest of 120 bushels per acre.

Ten lots of pure stock of Green Mountain from different growers from 160 1-2 bushels per acre to 313 bushels per acre, a difference of 152 1-2 bushels. Seventeen lots of Irish Cobbie ranged from 93 bushels per acre as the poorest to 235 bushels as the best, a difference in favor of the best yielding strain of 142 bushels. This would show that there may be as great a difference between potatoes of the same variety as there is between a potato of different varieties and that it is wise to secure stock from farms which have had high yielding crops. Because the Green Mountain has failed in giving a crop on a certain farm is not proof that this variety will not yield well there; it may have been due to low vitality in the seed stock. Such a version in yield may have been due to disease, or adverse soil or climatic conditions which affected the crop at some time and it may be better to discard the stock entirely than to try to bring it up to its former vitality by selection.

It is the opinion of military experts that the British are now in a position to strike a blow in Asia Minor which will have an important effect on the entire Allied campaign before the middle of 1917. They believe that a second line of attack upon Bagdad, by way of the Euphrates, can be developed. One observer says:
