APPEAL TO THE MONROE DOCTRINE

To judge from despatches received to-day, the governments of the South American republics are inclined to view with alarm the coercive measures adopted by Great Britain and Germany to collect debts from Venezuela, comments the Hamilton Herald. It is reported that Argentina will make formal inquiry of the Washington government whether the action of the two European governments does not infringe on the Monroe doctrine and whether the Washington government intends to remain passive. Chili will make similar enquiries, and probably other South American governments will follow suit.

This Venezuelan unpleasantness is likely, therefore, to bring about one useful result: it may serve to have about an unmistakable understanding with regard to the scope of the Monroe doctrine. Such an understanding is needed, for the bumptiousness of some of the South American republics is to be accounted for largely by their confidence that, no matter how offensive may be their conduct towards European nations, the government at Washington will protect them from the just consequences of their acts.

It is very improbable that Britain and Germany would resort to the extreme measures which they have taken to bring Venezuela to time without having first arrived at a thorough understanding with the United States government. There is therefore very little prospect of interference by President Roosevelt in behalf of Venezuela. So far there has been no violation of Monroe's doctrine by either of the European powers. They have not "interfered for the purpose of oppressing" Venezuela, "or controlling in any manner its destiny." All they have done is to adopt a rather rigorous method of compelling Venezuela to pay her debts due British and German subjects. When the Venezuela government either pays or makes satisfactory arrangements for payment, Britain and Germany will doubtless call off their dogs.

Even if the Washington government were inclined to stretch the Monroe doctrine to an extreme limit, as Secretary Olney did in 1895, in order to justify interference, there is a very powerful reason for resisting the temptation. That reason is indicated by the following statistics:

The trade of the United States with the United Kingdom for the ten months to October 31 last was \$558,881,252, of which \$418,483,969 was in exports. Its trade with Germany for the same period was \$229,737,302, and with Canada \$139,577,092, making a grand total of \$928,195,646, to say nothing of its trade with other parts of the British empire.
