## Mormons Building Big Temple in Canada.

Mormonism in Canada will centre around the town of Cardston, in Alberta, where a large temple is being constructed by people of this faith. Here has been the greatest gathering place of the immigrants from Utah, who have established themselves in a land that is wonderfully fertile and promising. The temple, according to an illustrated article in the Popular Mechanics Magazine, will cost \$1,000,000, is built in the form of a Maltese cross and from a distance gives the impression of a huge pyramid, being 118 ft. square and more than 100 ft. in height. On closer inspection, however, the beauty of the structure becomes apparent, with its light-gray granite and concrete outer walls, etc. in thickness and its simple straight lines.

This temple has been under construction for several years and sometime during next summer, will be held the dedication services. After these rites, entrance to the edifice will be denied to all non-believers and even to those of the same religion who do not totally abstain from the use of tobacco, coffee, tea and alcoholic stimulants, which abstinence is among the requirements of those desiring to be in good standing among the Mormons, according to their iron-clad rules.—Popular Mechanics.

## "Bulies" and "Humbugs."

Animals, birds, insects have "bulies" and "humbugs" among them just the same as people.

One of the greatest "humbugs" in the bird family is a pretty top-knotted fellow commonly known as the "pee-wee." When any one approaches the nest of this bird, he flies up with a whirring sound and drops to the ground a few yards distant. There he flounders and flutters as if he was wounded. He keeps on repeating this stunt until the trespasser is led a sufficient distance from the eggs or the young, and then the deceitful "pee-wee" flies straight back to the place from which he came.

There are several other birds that feign broken wings and legs when they want to decoy hunters from their nesting-places. The robin and mocking bird also belong to this set of "humbugs."

The garden caterpillar is a "bully." He has no poison, no spines, and nothing with which to defend himself, but the instant anything approaches, he rears up, shakes his horned head like an angry bull and looks so fierce nothing will touch him.

The opossum is one of the worst kind of pretenders. He plays dead at the slightest provocation, but as soon as he knows he is left alone loses no time in getting out of sight. There are several varieties of opossum, some as small as an ordinary rat, and others as large as a good-sized dog. Whether big or little, they all have the same-ly habit.

There are snakes, too, that have the pretending habit. One known as the "anout" snake is an expert in the line. When he is pursued, he writhes his body as if in convulsions, rolls over, shakes slowly, and then remains perfectly motionless. He has been known to "sham" hours at a time.

The porcupine is a "bluffer," and it is well that he is. He turns himself into a bristling ball and rattles his quills together, making a big noise for a small animal. He is always afraid himself, but with his noise and quivering spine, he "bluffs" the other fellow into letting him alone.

## Leif Erickson Was Here About A.D. 1000.

More and more people are coming to understand that Christopher Columbus was not the discoverer of America—that he may have been a rediscoverer so far as the people of Central and Southern Europe were concerned, but he was not the "first" discoverer. Of course our continent may have been discovered before Leif Erickson discovered it, but Leif was here more than four hundred years ahead of Columbus. It has been established to the satisfaction of all scholars who have concerned

themselves with this subject that Leif was really and truly here. A recent writer on this matter has said: "The evidence that Leif Erickson came to the North American coast in the year 1000 and that he returned to Europe making his discovery known to the world, is clearly authentic." Leif is defended against the charge of being a "barbarous Norse adventurer" though he might have been all that, and also the discoverer of America. It is maintained that Leif represented the highest type of the Scandinavian civilization of that time, which had risen above the decadent Roman culture of Southern Europe.

The Sagas say that Leif was a large, powerful man of most imposing bearing, "a man of sagacity and just in all things." Before his discovery of America he had been converted to the Christian faith and had been commissioned by King Olaf to proclaim the faith to the people of Greenland, which the Scandinavians had settled a considerable period before that time. It is quite reasonable to believe that the Norsemen who had settled in Greenland had made voyages to America in advance of Leif Erickson, but that Leif was there in 1000 or nearly 100 years before Columbus there is no doubt.
