COUNTY COUNCIL
PAYS HONOR TO
POPULAR WARDEN

Present Magnificent Cabinet of Silver To William Ross.

SPLENDID BANQUET

Warden William Ross, one of the most popular men who ever presided over a Middlesex county council was host to the councillors last night at a splendid banquet in the Griggs House. County officials and their wives were also among the guests of honor.

During the evening the warden was presented with a magnificent cabinet of silver by the members of the council, the address being read by A. L. McDougall, the presentation being made by C. C. Henry.

The address which accompanied the cabinet of silver was as follows: "At this the last session of the county council for the year we desire to avail ourselves of this opportunity of expressing to you our sincere appreciation of the kind, courteous and efficient manner in which you have directed the business of this council and performed the many other details of the office of warden."

"Although having the advantage of but few years' practical experience in municipal affairs, it was early recognized that you possessed the characteristics of one admirably fitted to guide the deliberations of those who serve under you."

"Many times, no doubt, some of us have said things that tried your patience and which would have irritated many others, but by your quiet and unassuming manner and your tact and ability at all times, you have won the confidence and esteem of all."

"That our appreciation may not be expressed in words only, we ask you to accept this cabinet of silver and in the years to come as you use it daily, may it remind you of your associates during the year in which you so ably discharged the duties of your important office."

In thanking the members of the council, Warden Ross stated it had been a pleasure to act as warden during the year, because he had the whole county council at his back. From January to December there hadn't been one member of the council who had tried to put him in a hole.

Archie Ferguson, ex-reeve of Lobo, who acted as chairman of the evening, referred in glowing terms to the ability of the warden. He also mentioned the fine service that J. S. Cousins had rendered the county and the township of Westminster. "Mr. Cousins' work when he was warden was certainly an inspiration to every member of the council," declared Mr. Ferguson.

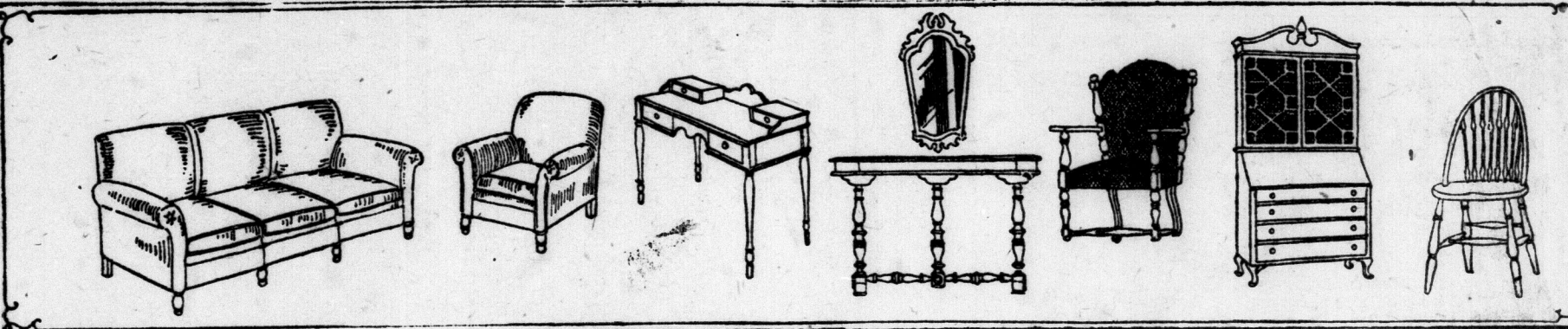

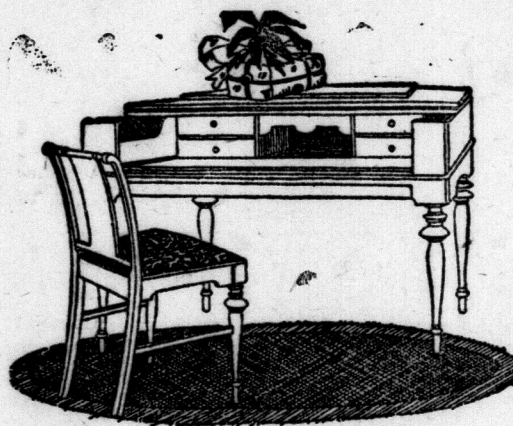

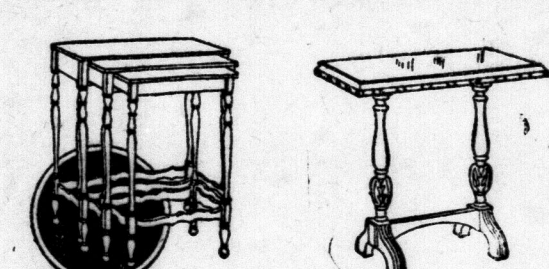
