The accompanying form is a duplicate (reduced) of a payroll sheet prepared on a Burroughs Adding Machine in a Government department at Ottawa. Two and a half days are saved every month on this work alone. Virtually all other figure work in the department is done on the same machine, thus saving many days and much labour. The head of this particular department declares that it would be very difficult to get along without the machine.

Published Government figures show that during the past year letters of credit involving 4,413,758 cheques, which totaled \$469,984,470.62 were adjusted in the finance department at Ottawa.
