The Department of External Affairs announced today that the Honourable George C. Marler, Minister of Transport, is the Chairman of the Canadian Delegation to the Assembly of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), which convened its Tenth Session at Caracas, Venezuela on Tuesday, June 19.

The Vice-Chairman of the Delegation is R.M. Macdonnell, Deputy Under-Secretary of the Department of External Affairs; and included on the Delegation are Mr. J.A. Irwin, the Canadian Representative of the ICAO Council, Mr. C.S. Booth, the Assistant Deputy Minister of the Department of Transport, Mr. G. Morisset, Member of the Air Transport Board, Mr. S. Pollock of the Department of Finance.

The annual Assembly Meeting of ICAO which at present includes sixty-nine Member States holds a major session every three years. The meeting in Caracas is the first Assembly to take place in Latin America.
