

GENERAL BUSINESS OF THE SENATE.

DEBATES, DIVISIONS, AND PROTESTS.

Daily Sittings.

3. The time for the ordinary meeting of the Senate is at Three o'clock in the afternoon, unless some other time shall have previously been ordered.

Emergency Sittings.

4. If at Six o'clock the business be not concluded, the Speaker leaves the Chair, and half-past Seven o'clock, the Mace being left on the Table.

No Speeches.

5. If thirty minutes after the time at which it is usual to speak have elapsed, and the business be not completed, the Speaker shall direct the members of the Senate until the next day to abstain from speaking, and the Senate, as previously ordered, shall adjourn.
