

Canada, the amount of which shall be fixed annually by the Dominion Convention. This tax shall be paid out of the general fund of every Local Branch and remitted in quarterly payments directly to the office of the Dominion Command, and shall be calculated on the number of members in the Branch not more than three months in arrears.

#### Provincial Per Capita Tax.

Sec. 35.—For the support and maintenance of the Provincial Command (when existent) there shall be levied a Per Capita Tax on each and every member of the whole Provincial body, the amount of which shall be fixed annually by the Provincial Convention. This tax shall be paid out of the general fund of every Local Branch in the Province and remitted in quarterly payments directly to the office of the Provincial Command and shall be calculated on the number of members in the Branch not more than three months in arrears.

### **ARTICLE V.**

#### **EXECUTIVES.**

##### **Dominion Executive**

Sec. 36.—The Dominion Executive shall consist of a President, First Vice-President and Second Vice-President, who shall be elected at the Annual Dominion Convention by vote of the whole Convention, and of one representative from every Province which representative shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Convention by the vote only of the delegates from the Province that he is to represent.

Sec. 37.—The Dominion Executive shall have power to perform and carry to completion work entrusted to it by the Annual Convention, or these Rules and Regulations, to fill all vacancies arising during recess, to supply all omissions left undone by the Convention, and generally to enact Rules and Regulations governing the business of the Association not inconsistent with these Rules and Regulations or the expressed will of the Convention. Provided, such Rules and
