

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-1.

An Act for the relief of Madeleine Francoise Hankowski.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Madeleine Francoise Hankowski, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, wife of Jan Paul Hankowski, who is domiciled in Canada and temporarily residing at the city of New York, in the state of New York, one of the United States of America, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the fifteenth day of October, A.D. 1955, at the said city of Montreal, she then being Madeleine Francoise Patenaude; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
