I SHALL in the following Account omit the Accidents that befel us in our Passage, being such as are inseparable from all great Voyages, and begin with my Arrival at *Quebec*, from whence we went up the River *St. Lawrence* Southwards, till we came to *Fort Frontenac*, distant from *Quebec* one hundred Leagues. It was built to prevent the Excursions of the *Iroquese*, and to interrupt the Trade of Skins, these Savages maintain with the Inhabitants of *New-York*, who furnish them with Commodities at cheaper Rates than the *French* of *Canada*.
