mittees of his Privy Council, and, amongst the rest, a Committee for the Business of Trade, under whose Consideration was to come whatfoever concerned his Majesty's foreign Plantations, and also what related to his Kingdoms of Scotland or Ireland, in such Matters only relating to either of those Kingdoms as properly belonged to the Cognizance of the Council Board; the Isles of Guern-Jey and Fersey: which was to confift of the Lord Privy Scal, Duke of Bucks, &c.
