was unattempted in 1756, to all Appearance through mere Cowardice; and that Ofwego was lost through Cowardice or through Negligence. The Design against Louisbourgh was ineffectual, because it could not be executed at a proper Season; and the Loss of Fort William-Henry was the Effect of Ignorance and Delay.

Thus unfuccessful have we been in America; and yet what we have done in Europe only adds to the Weight of our Misfortunes, and, if possible, heightens our Disgrace.
