Do I acknowledge that all light, and truth,—all holy desires, and conduct pleasing to God, is the work of his Holy Spirit and can only dwell in me by his influence ?

Do I fervently pray for his heavenly teaching, and gifts ; such as faith—hope—charity—delight in God,—and conformity to the image and likeness of Christ ?
