Waiting Day in Wheat Market Gov't Report Issued at Close

September Option Scores Small Advance, But Prices Drift Back and Forth in Narrow Range—Corn and Oats Lower.

CHICAGO, Sept. 8.—It was generally expected that the condition of spring wheat would be put by the government at about 50 per cent. indicating a crop of 215,000,000 bu. Instead the official announcement was 56.7 per cent. from which it was estimated that the yield would be only 203,000,000 bu. While waiting for the news from Washington dealers found business light and prices narrow. During the day December prices for September wheat ranged from 96 1/2 to 97 1/2 cent, with last sales 1-2c to 1-4c net lower at 96 1/2 to 96 7/8 cent.

Corn declined, owing to a belief that the government figures on the crop would be increased. The idea turned out to be correct, but the total, nevertheless, proved much under what had been looked for. December ranged between 43 1/2 to 44 1/2 cent, closing easy 3-8c off at 43 1/2 to 43 5/8 cent. Cash grades were steady.

Oats were depressed as a result of a bullish report on corn. High and low prices touched by the 1-2c to 1-3c. The wheat was 4-7-8c to 4-6c, showed a net loss of 1-4c to 3-8c.

European Grain Exchange. The Liverpool market closed yesterday unchanged to 1/4 lower on wheat, and unchanged to 1/4 lower on corn. Berlin closed 1/4 higher on wheat, and unchanged on corn.

Winnipeg Inspection. Winnipeg receipts of wheat to-day graded as follows: No. 1 northern, 2,400; No. 2 northern, 1,200; No. 3 northern, 1,200; No. 4 northern, 1,200; winter wheat, 4,000; receipts were 2 cars, barley, 7; none.

Argentine Shipments. The weekly Argentine shipments follow: This week last, last year. Wheat, 1,235,000; Corn, 1,120,000; Flour, 1,270,000; Barley, 1,270,000.

World's Estimates. The weekly estimates of wheat and flour shipments for the week, exclusive of North America, at 8,000,000 bushels. The United Kingdom will aggregate about 6,000,000 bushels. He predicts there will be a fair decrease in exports.
