Maud Keswick First in 2.18 Pace—Summary of Grand Circuit Trotting

Buffalo, Aug. 10.—Sweet Marie, 2048, the McKinney mare which took the measure of Tiverton in the match race in Beadville last week, had the tables turned on her effectively to-day in the free-for-all.

The feature event of the Grand Circuit, at Kenilworth Park, when the Gallop-trot stallion took down first money in the two last heats of the race, was the match getting the third heat 2:06 1/2, but after the result of the race had been settled according to the three heats in question here.

George G. and McKinley completed the quartet which faced the starter for the event in the opening heats Sweet Marie sold at \$200, with \$80 on Tiverton and \$100 on the mare.

The mare got her catching Tiverton in the stretch in the first heat, when she broke and finished last. Still Sweet Marie sold favorite at \$20 to \$27 on the field, but third to Tiverton was the best she could do. In the last heat McDonald got her stepping thru the stretch, and she overhauled and beat Tiverton half a length in a whipping finish.

This blow was one of the worst the talent has suffered at the meeting, although Tiverton was supported handsomely. Those who saw Sadie Mac, Miss Wilkes trotter, step away with the \$100,900 on the field, will remember the belief that the Galt woman fancier owns the real trotting champion among the three-year-olds.
