WAR BONDS STRONG, OTHER ISSUES EASIER

Sugar and Steel of Canada Down, But Brazilian Sells Up Fractionally. With New York closed and only a morning session for business little was expected at the Toronto Stock Exchange yesterday. The speculative activity of the market evinced no change, but the definite betterment in the highest class bonds noted on Monday was again conspicuous. Liquidation in war bonds and the Victory issue has been quite pronounced for several months, and by the necessity of securing funds not otherwise available. This liquidation is thought to have abated, run its course and purchases of each of the three issues compelled advance.

FRENCH RENTES OFFERED TO CANADIAN INVESTORS

The loan is offered in France and proceeds of sale will be accumulated here on behalf of the French government.
