

MURRAY JAMESON OF CLOVER HILL, KINGS COUNTY IS KILLED

(Kings County Record) The sad intelligence of the death of Murray Jameson, Clover Hill, was received on Tuesday by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Alex. Jameson.

He was in New York when he was killed, and wrote home that he intended to enlist, and first thought of going with Major Anderson, of Moncton, who was then recruiting an artillery unit.

On June 21st he entered the trenches, and after two weeks' service was badly wounded during the big offensive, in which none won more credit than the Middlesex Regiment.

The letter conveying the sad news of his death was as follows: Dear Mrs. Jameson: I regret to inform you that your son, Murray Jameson, of the M. G. Corps, has died of wounds in the hospital on July 4th.

I hope that God will be very near you and give you grace to carry your cross. It may be consolation to know that your son has died for his country and that his sacrifice will not be in vain.
