

Winnipeg, Feb. 18—In the first division of the provincial session today the Norris government was successful, the Laborites' resolution for the unconditional release of the strike leaders, three of whom are members of the legislature, being defeated by 26 votes to 22. The vote resolved itself into practically a straight fight between the Liberals and Conservatives on the one hand and the Laborites and the Independent-Farmers on the other. As a result of the division the house went on record as urging the release of the strike leaders on condition that they ask for parole.


