Synod met and was constituted with prayer, Minutes were and sustained.

Overture from Presbytery of St. John relative to Charter Overture on s withdrawn with permission of Synod.

Overture relative to support of Free Church College at Overture on F. C. College. alifax was then read, viz :-

Whereas it appears that the current expenses of the es Church College of Halifax are not fully met by the lections made on behalf of them by the Free Synod of ova Scotia, and also that subscriptions towards the Enwment of the College promised by parties in N. B., are several cases unpaid; and whereas New Brunswick has rived and will derive many advantages from this instituon, and for this and other reasons ought to aid in its suprt; the Presbytery of St. Stephen humbly overture the unod that the above facts be taken into its consideration ith a view to such aid being rendered in the premises as the Synod may seem best."

Adoption of Overture was moved by Mr. Elder, seconded Mr. Turnbull, and agreed to. Synod further resolved at an appeal be made to our people to increase the Inciental Fund by Congregational collections and individual subriptions, and that should the state of the fund at the next eeting of the Synod enable the Synod so to do, a portion of e fund shall be allocated to this object; and that the Clerk the Synod be Treasurer of the Incidental Fund, and that e be instructed to endeavour to advadce its interests.
