

The County of West York returns 6 Lodges working, with a membership of 142.

The members will see from the foregoing statement that the returns are as yet very incomplete.

During the past year 11 new Warrants have been issued, as follows:—

Making a total of nine Warrants surrendered. In looking over the returns, I find that L. O. L. 815, in the County of West Bruce, was declared dormant by Grand Lodge, June, 1881, and afterwards paid up back dues and went on working without any authority from the Grand Lodge. L. O. L. 1008, declared dormant by Grand Lodge, June, 1881, is returned by County of North Grey this year, but nothing is said about Grand Lodge dues. These Lodges should not be working without the authority of the Grand Lodge, and I would recommend these cases to be referred to the Warrant Committee.

At the meeting of the M. W. Grand Lodge, the Committee on Revision of Constitution was continued, and new members added, so that it will be probably be another year before the Revision is completed.

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
