Every Joining Member shall pay the sum of Five dollars, which shall include the fee for registry, but if he requires a Grand Conclave Certificate, he must pay a further sum of Two dollars. His proposer is responsible for these Fees, to be paid at the time of admittance.

For Dues every Member of this Encampment shall pay at each regular assembly the sum of Fifty cents, and for the Banquet, if present, One dollar and fifty cents.

XII.

Honorary Members shall be exempt from dues, and may speak and vote on all questions. They must be proposed and seconded, and admitted by unanimous and open vote of the Members present. The proposition must be inserted in the summonses.

XIII.

The Equerry shall be exempt from payment of dues, and shall receive an allowance of one dollar and fifty cents for every assembly.

XIV.
