

XVII. All general orders of the said Court of Chancery now standing unrepealed by the said Court, are hereby confirmed and declared to be to all intents and purposes as effectual as if the same were hereby specially enacted; but the same may from time to time be suspended, repealed, varied and re-enacted by the said Court, and shall in all respects be subject to the control and direction of the said Court and the respective Judges of the said Court, as in the case of any other general orders of the said Court which may from time to time be hereafter made by the said Court under the general or other jurisdiction thereof in that behalf; and the said Court shall from time to time make such general orders as may be necessary or proper to carry out the provisions of this Act, and may from time to time repeal, vary and amend such orders according as the said Court shall find expedient.
