An Act to remove certain doubts as to the mode of making searches in the Registry Offices in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS it is necessary to remove doubts as to the mode of making searches in the Registry Offices established in Lower Canada, and as the fees which the Registrar is entitled to receive for every such search; Be it therefore enacted, &c',

Preamble.

5 That it shall be lawful for any person desirous of making searches in the Registry Offices to make them in presence of the Registrar or his deputy, and in the case of any such search, if the Registrar is not required to give a certificate in writing, he shall be entitled to receive *one shilling* for every such search, which shall not last
10 longer than one half hour and *one shilling* more for each additional half hour.

Parties may make searches for themselves.
