

LONDON (BPI) An unidentified Canadian university student was arrested Tuesday morning in the British Museum Reading Room.

Government spokespersons confirmed the arrest following in announcement by the Prime Minister in a House of Comnons special session.

In her statement to Parliment, the Prime Minister said the arrest was carried out by a special force involving over 40 people from Scotland Yard, MI5, MI6, and UN Security

However, in an unprecedented move, Her Royal Highness, Queen Elizabeth II ordered that the Canadian student be released. Sources at Buckingham Palace report that the student was then taken to Balmoral Castle where he was to meet with Queen Elizabeth, and Heads of States from a lot of countries.

Scotland Yard and MI5 have also announced that they are presently searching for a British subject who had recently completed university studies n Canada and is believed to be somehow connected to all this

In another unprecedented move, Queen Elizabeth told Scotland Yard and MI5 to Out of reach. bugger off and go find something useful to do."

Witnesses to the arrest at the Pretty Museum Reading Room gave vague and conflicting descriptions of the student. All confirmed, however, that the student was shouting something about the Canada-U.S. Free Trade Agreement, Prime Minister Thatcher's comments on it, and a large semi-intelligent bottle of beer just prior to the arrest.

Unconfirmed reports suggest that the Canadian student was seen leaving Balmoral Castle piloting a Soviet-style nelicopter that had apparently been undergoing repairs at a secret Government garage under the Castle.
