

No. 5 I.T.S. to Hold 'Open House' Wed. Afternoon

To give Belleville and district residents an idea of how their Victory Loan dollars are being spent in the Royal Canadian Air Force to train the airmen who will later batter the German Luftwaffe and raze Nazi industrial sites to the ground officers at No. 5 Initial Training School at Belleville have arranged to hold "open house" on Wednesday afternoon from two until five in the afternoon.

Arranged with the kind permission of Wing Commander A. J. Snetsinger, E.D., commanding officer of the station, the program for the afternoon will be under the direction of Squadron Leader Fortune with conducted tours to be made through the various departments of the training station.

Personnel of the station will carry on as usual with their customary duties during the afternoon and visitors will be enabled to see the exact training schedule which boys in air force blue undergo at the local initial training school. No special activities are being planned as the usual training schedule will be strictly adhered to, according to station officers.

Scheduled as it is for the closing week of the Fifth Victory Loan campaign, the "open house" planned for No. 5 I.T.S. on the half holiday will be a splendid opportunity for city residents to do something a bit out of the ordinary for the afternoon and at the same time gain a greater appreciation of the cost of training aircrew.

Officers of the station have extended a cordial invitation to any who may care to visit the training base during the afternoon.
