(returned Feb.26/43) No reply has yet been recvd. to telegram No.228 of Feb.28/43 to High Comm'r, London. ✓ Telegram No.482 of Mar.26/43 to High Comm'r, London, reminding UK govt. that Can. govt. desire that agreed statements be made simultaneously here and in London and stating that Canada wd. take no further action until word had been recvd. from D.O. or H.C. as to UK intentions.
