

With reference to your letter of the 25th instant, relative to the appointment of Dr Carthew (whose initials are C.E.) as medical officer for the Indians of Wabuman Reserve (also known as Paul's Reserve on White Horse Lake) I beg to say that the \$10.00 per day which he is to receive under the "Call System" is to cover both expenses and services. He is to attend only at the above mentioned reserve.

You will be advised later with regard to medical services for the other reserves in the Edmonton Agency.
