Sir,—

Referring to your communication of the 27th of June last, No. 28318, and prior correspondence, in regard to application for one of the islands of the San Miguel Group, opposite to and forming part of the Puquet Indian Reserve, No. 1, in Friendly Cove, N. C., I beg to say that the consent of His Excellency in Council has been given to the transfer to your Department for lighthouse purposes of the property in question, on condition that as much Indian labour as is reasonably possible shall be employed in the construction of the buildings and upon payment of the sum of \$100.
