
Ottawa, March 31, 1913.

Sir,

I beg to refer to requisition No. 677 of the 23rd of September, last, and to ask you to be good enough to advise whether the copies of "School and Home" for the Primary, First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth classes were ordered from The Educational Publishing Co. for a whole year or only for the term ending December 31st. They have not been forwarded to the teacher since the first of January and the Department wishes to take the matter up with the company, as there have been several complaints.

This Department believes that it is customary for public school teachers in the province of Ontario to order these twice a year, the first time for the term ending December 31st and the second for school term ending June 30th. It should be quite sufficient, however, if an order is placed for the whole year at once and I shall be pleased to hear from you so that the company can be written to.
