to be obtained on the ground might alter your views, or perhaps by settlement of the boundaries of the reserve, the question referred to you might also be

settled:

I trust, therefore, that you will in future be able to so act in matters affecting Indian lands that the Governments may not be left with any troublesome questions which might have been dealt with.
