regularly somewhat like ni in 'opinion'; it is formed by pressing the upper middle surface of the tongue against the roof of the mouth, the tip being at the same time thrust against the back surface of the lower front teeth — Symbol [n]: agneau [ano], digne [din], campagne [kāpan], gagner [gane], accompagner [akōpane], magnifique [manifik], règne [re:n].

EXCEPTION: gn = [g] + [n] in some learned words: cognition [kognisj5], etc.

h when heard at all, which occurs only in hiatus, has a sound much weaker than h in 'hat' — Symbol [h]: aha! [a(h)a].

Note. — The letter h is known as h mute (h muet) when it gives rise to elision and liaison (cf. N. O. below), e.g. l'homme [l əni], les hommes [les əm], and h aspirate (h aspiré) when it does not, e.g. le héros [le ero], les héros [le ero]. The learner should regard h as absolutely silent.

- j always has the same sound as g (2), above—Symbol [31: je [30], jeu [30], jour [3u:r]; so also je (e being regarded as silent); Jean [30].
- k, ck always like k in 'take' Symbol [k]: kilogramme [kilogram], bifteck [biftek].

NOTE. - k is a rare letter in French.

regularly like 1 in 'law,' fully voiced, but with the tongue advanced as for [d] — Symbol [l]: la [la], cale [kal], aller [ale], 'able [tabl], oncle [5:kl], ils [il], village [vila:3], fil [fil].

Notes. — 1. The sound of l is frequently doubled when written double in initial syllable: illégal [illegal], illustre [illystr]; and by some in words like intelligent.

2. The l is silent in fils [fis].

the letters il after i (not initial), and il or ill after other vowels, il(1)

have the same sound as that described for i as a semi-vowel (cf. L, above)—Symbol [j]: fille [fi:j], billet [bije], briller [brije], soleil [səle:j], feuille [fœ:j], fauteuil [fotæ:j], écureuil [ekyrœ:j], bataille [bata:j], travail [trava:j], travailler [trava;e].

NOTE. - This sound of I is ealled I mouillé.

EXCEPTIONS: mille [mil], millier [milje], million [miljo], ville [vil], village [vila:3], tranquille [trākil], etc.

m regularly like m in 'maim,' fully voiced — Symbol [m]: même [me:m], mot [mo], dame [dam], plume [plym], mon [m5], homme [om], femme [fam].

Exceptions: m is silent in automne [oton], condamner [k5dane].
