of debates shall be permitted, but the main question shall be put without delay.

- 11. No amendment to a motion can be received after an amendment to an amendment, nor any motion except to adjourn, to resolve into Committee, the previous question, or to lay on the table.
- 12. The yeas and nays upon any question shall be recorded in the minutes when called for by five members.
- 13. When the Convention is resolved into Committee, no motion can be entertained except, "That this Committee rise," which shall be voted on without debate, but cannot be again put without permission of the Chairman.
- 14. After adoption, the minutes shall be signed by the President, and countersigned by the Secretary.
