THOMAS WHITTAKER'S NEW BOOKS.

A Book for Canadian Churchmen.

The Church in Nova Scotia, and the Tory Clergy of the Revolution. By
Rev. Arthur Wentworth Eaton, B. A. 12mo., cloth, \$1.50 net.

The author is thoroughly familiar with the history and traditions of the "Acadian
Land," especially with that unique event, the emigration of between thirty and forty
thousand Loyalists—mainly Churchmen—to Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, at the
time of the American Revolution. In this volume, for the first time, the history of the
Church in Nova Scotia, from before the founding of Halifax in 1749, is rapidly and
picturesquely sketched, special attention being given to the lives of the thirty Loyalist
clergymen who went from the older colonies to the maritime provinces, where many of
them spent the rest of their lives. There will be found in its pages a faithful portrayal
of the chief historical facts of this oldest Colonial Diocese of the British Empire. The
book is one that every person interested in the history of the Church on this continent
should read.
