

(b) Satisfactory evidence that he is a registered physician and surgeon of Manitoba;

(c) A certificate, under the seal of the University of Manitoba, that he has complied with the conditions set forth by the University of Manitoba entitling him to be admitted as such licentiate.

Sec. 4.—Any person possessing the certificate of qualification of The Dominion Dental Council desiring to obtain a certificate of license to practice dentistry in Manitoba, shall make written application therefor to the Secretary, and with such application shall forward to the Secretary the following:

(a) The required fee for such license;

(b) Satisfactory evidence that he is possessed of the certificate of qualification of The Dominion Dental Council.

Sec. 5.—All other persons desiring to obtain a certificate of license to practice dentistry in Manitoba shall make written application therefor to the Secretary, and with such application shall forward to the Secretary the following:

(a) The required fee for such license;

(b) Satisfactory evidence that he is of the age of twenty-one years;

(c) Satisfactory evidence of good conduct and character;

(d) A certificate, under the seal of the University of Manitoba, that he is by way of dental education and otherwise a proper person to be registered as a Licentiate of Dental Surgery in Manitoba.

#### BY-LAW 9.—FEES

The following are the fees required to be paid:

For registration as a student of dentistry, which includes the fee for filing articles of indenture, \$10;

~~X~~ For temporary license under sub-section (c) of section 19 of "The Dental Association Act," \$100. ~~X~~

For certificate of Licentiate of Dental Surgery:

(a) When applicant is a Manitoba indentured student of four years, \$50;

~~X~~ (b) When applicant has already paid the fee for temporary license under sub-section (c) of section 19 of "The Dental Association Act," \$25; ~~X~~

(c) In all other cases, \$100.  
Annual registration fee, \$5.
