A Return of all duties, levied by means of Imperial Acts, on goods of every description imported into this Colony.

A Return of all duties, levied by means of Local Acts, on goods of every description imported into this Colony.

A Return showing the amount of duty to be levied on each article of import, provided the duties now imposed by means of Local and Imperial Acts were consolidated, and formed but one Act. That is: a tabular statement enumerating the articles, and exhibiting opposite each the whole amount of duty to be levied under the contemplated change.

A Return of all the annual expenditure of the Customs' Department, distinguishing the Imperial from the Colonial: also, of the Officers of Customs', whether Colonial or Imperial.
