

TO PROBE THE DREDGING GRAFT. A thorough investigation into the dredging contracts of the old government has been decided upon by

Hon. Robert Rogers, Minister Public Works, and Hugh Stewart, R.C. of Brockville, has been retained as counsel to conduct the probe before the public accounts committee. Some sensational evidence it is expected will be forthcoming as it is well-known that the dredging confruitful source of graft.
